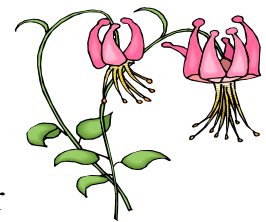

Rothea incisa, Clerodemrum incisum macrosiphon

Average Mature Size: 3-5' H x 4-5' W

Outdoor light: Full Sun, Part Sun, Part Shade

Indoor light: High

Buds open at night, blooms almost continuously throughout the warmer months. Does not tolerate temps much below 30F. An excellent and easy plant for containers.
